THE PIERCE BACKYARD, 2021

2022 was a landmark year for White Oak Bicycle Co-op. Grassroots beginnings and homegrown efforts grew into serving more people than ever before. What once started as a backyard hobby during the pandemic has grown exponentially in two short years. Check out some of our biggest highlights of the year:

- Significant increase (+126%) in bicycles donated back to the community in 2022, 2022=402; 2021=178; 2020=38
- Partnered with UTC's Master of Public Health Program to offer experiential learning opportunities for graduate students
- Expanded beyond the garage thanks to the generosity of Mohawk Canoes, Rise Partners, & White Oak UMC
- Celebrated the opening of the South Chickamauga Greenway by providing free bicycles and repair services to children and youth in the Cromwell Hills neighborhood
- Celebrated the opening of the White Oak Connector Trail in partnership with the City of Red Bank and the Trust for Public Land
- Supported the protection, preservation, and memorialization of the recently discovered African-American cemetery in the White Oak area of Red Bank
- Secured a grant from the Tennessee Highway Safety Office for Bicycle and Pedestrian Safety Education
